about the speakers

Tracy Finnegan was formerly associated with Nalco Chemical Company, where she worked for more than 17 years in numerous positions related to research, operations, design evaluation, auditing and troubleshooting. She now started her own Environmental Engineering Company that supplies wastewater products, training, audits and consulting services. Tracy has taught biological wastewater process control to operators and engineers for over 17 years and performed audits and troubleshooting for ~5-6000 industrial and municipal treatment plants worldwide. Tracy holds a BS degree in Business Chemistry from Northern Illinois University. She is a contributing author in WEFTEC's Book-Wastewater Biology: The Microlife. She has written 12 Wastewater training manuals and CD's.

Dr. Cary Jackson is a nationally and internationally recognized expert with over 32 years experience in water, water science, and regulatory science affairs activities. As a principle consultant to EPA Office of Water, he has developed, co-developed, or managed the development of over 30 promulgated test methods for use in regulatory compliance monitoring and reporting purposes. Currently with Hach Company, Dr. Jackson directs the regulatory affairs activities for EPA and consensus-based method approvals where he is a task chair for ASTM International D19 Water, a US delegate to ISO, and a Federal Advisor to EPA on detection and quantitation. Dr. Jackson holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in chemistry from University of Northern Colorado and a Doctorate of Philosophy degree in Soil Chemistry from Colorado State University. Dr. Jackson's most recent regulatory interests include luminescent dissolved oxygen, amperometric chlorine probes, and green chemistry test methods.

This seminar was organized by The Central States Water Environment Association, Laboratory Committee and Illinois Water Environment Association Laboratory Committee.

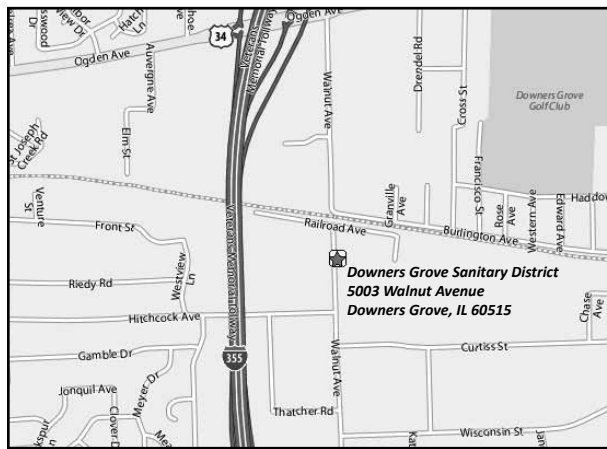

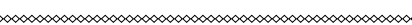
